1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to public safety; reporting law enforcement use of force; requiring reports;

1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 626.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 626.5534 USE OF FORCE REPORTING.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Report required. A chief law enforcement officer must provide the

1.7 information requested by the Federal Bureau of Investigation about each incident of law

1.8 enforcement use of force resulting in serious bodily harm or death, as those terms are defined

1.9 in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's reporting requirements, to the superintendent of the

1.10 Bureau of Criminal Apprehension. The superintendent shall adopt a reporting form for use

1.11 by law enforcement agencies in making the report required under this section. The report

1.12 must include for each incident all of the information requested by the Federal Bureau of

1.13 Investigation.

1.14 Subd. 2. Use of information collected. A chief law enforcement officer must file the

1.15 report under subdivision 1 once a month in the form required by the superintendent. The

1.16 superintendent must summarize and analyze the information received and submit an annual

1.17 written report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house of representatives

1.18 and senate committees with jurisdiction over public safety. The superintendent shall submit

1.19 the information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
