BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [122A.78] PAID STUDENT TEACHING.

- Subdivision 1. Establishment. (a) The commissioner of education must develop a system
 to provide teacher candidates who are completing field-specific student teaching requirements
 of a Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board-approved teacher preparation
 program with a stipend during the student teaching period.
 - (b) For purposes of this section, student teachers are considered temporary employees and are not eligible to enroll in local bargaining units or eligible for locally bargained benefits.
 - (c) Minnesota districts and charter schools that host student teachers must provide student teacher stipends under this section. One-half of the stipend must be paid at the beginning of the student teaching experience. The other half of the stipend must be paid at the conclusion of the student teaching experience. Host schools must be reimbursed by the Department of Education as described in this section.
- Subd. 2. Paid student teaching formula. (a) By March 31 of each year, Professional
 Educator Licensing and Standards Board-approved teacher preparation programs
 collaborating with the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board must provide
 the commissioner of education with a projected number of student teachers for the following
 school year.
