1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for asset preservation at Como

1.3 Zoo; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **COMO ZOO ASSET PRESERVATION.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.7 to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to the city of St. Paul for energy efficiency updates

1.8 and asset preservation improvements and betterments of a capital nature to infrastructure

1.9 and exhibits at Como Zoo.

1.10 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.11 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.12 the state in an amount up to \$2,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.13 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.14 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
