- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 609.66, subdivision 1e, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 1e. **Felony; drive-by shooting.** (a) ~~Whoever,~~ A person is guilty of a felony who,
- 1.7 while in or having just exited from a motor vehicle, recklessly discharges a firearm at or
- 1.8 toward ~~another~~ ;
- 1.9 (1) an unoccupied motor vehicle or a building is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced
- 1.10 to imprisonment for not more than three years or to payment of a fine of not more than
- 1.11 \$6,000, or both;
- 1.12 (2) a motor vehicle or building that was occupied; or
- 1.13 (3) another person.
- 1.14 (b) ~~Any person who violates this subdivision by firing at or toward a person, or an~~
- 1.15 ~~occupied building or motor vehicle, may be sentenced~~ A person convicted under paragraph
- 1.16 (a), clause (1), may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than three years or to payment
- 1.17 of a fine of not more than \$6,000, or both. A person convicted under paragraph (a), clause
- 1.18 (2) or (3), may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than ten years or to payment of
