1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 144A.70, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8 to read:

1.9 Subd. 4a. **Nurse.** "Nurse" means a licensed practical nurse as defined in section 148.171,

1.10 subdivision 8, or a registered nurse as defined in section 148.171, subdivision 20.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.12 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 144A.70, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.13 Subd. 6. **Supplemental nursing services agency.** "Supplemental nursing services

1.14 agency" means a person, firm, corporation, partnership, or association engaged for hire in

1.15 the business of providing or procuring temporary employment in health care facilities for

1.16 nurses, nursing assistants, nurse aides, and orderlies,~~and other licensed health professionals.~~

1.17 Supplemental nursing services agency does not include an individual who only engages in

1.18 providing the individual's services on a temporary basis to health care facilities. Supplemental

1.19 nursing services agency does not include a professional home care agency licensed under

1.20 section 144A.471 that only provides staff to other home care providers.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
