1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a grant to Pillsbury United
1.3 Communities for capital improvements related to the Pillsbury House Theatre.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; PILLSBURY UNITED COMMUNITIES.**

1.6 (a) \$27,800,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7 commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Pillsbury United
1.8 Communities, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, for capital improvements as provided in
1.9 this section.

1.10 (b) \$1,500,000 of this appropriation is to acquire property, predesign, design, construct,
1.11 renovate, furnish, and equip a studio technical arts campus for workforce development that
1.12 supports youth who are Black, Indigenous, and people of color in gaining skills related to
1.13 theatre technology, design, and media.

1.14 (c) \$26,300,000 of this appropriation is to predesign, design, construct, renovate, furnish,
1.15 and equip a renovation and expansion of the Pillsbury House Theatre to create interactive
1.16 and accessible space to be made available to and utilized by visitors, partner organizations,
1.17 artists, and the greater community to exchange ideas and build relationships.

1.18 (d) This is a onetime appropriation and is available until the project is completed or
1.19 abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
