OFFICIAL STATUS

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to natural resources; increasing certain penalties related to aquatic invasive
- 1.3 species; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 84D.13, subdivision 5.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 84D.13, subdivision 5, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 5. **Civil penalties.** (a) A civil citation issued under this section must impose the
- 1.7 following penalty amounts:
- 1.8 (1) for transporting aquatic macrophytes in violation of section 84D.09, ~~\$100~~ \$250;
- 1.9 (2) for placing or attempting to place into waters of the state water-related equipment
- 1.10 that has aquatic macrophytes attached, ~~\$200~~ \$250;
- 1.11 (3) for unlawfully possessing or transporting a prohibited invasive species other than an
- 1.12 aquatic macrophyte, ~~\$500~~ \$1,000;
- 1.13 (4) for placing or attempting to place into waters of the state water-related equipment
- 1.14 that has prohibited invasive species attached when the waters are not listed by the
- 1.15 commissioner as being infested with that invasive species, \$500;
- 1.16 (5) for intentionally damaging, moving, removing, or sinking a buoy marking, as
- 1.17 prescribed by rule, Eurasian watermilfoil, \$100;
- 1.18 (6) for failing to have drain plugs or similar devices removed or opened while transporting
- 1.19 water-related equipment or for failing to remove plugs, open valves, and drain water from
- 1.20 water-related equipment, other than marine sanitary systems, before leaving waters of the
- 1.21 state, ~~\$100~~ \$250;

2.1 (7) for transporting infested water off riparian property without a permit as required by
2.2 rule, ~~\$200~~ \$250;

2.3 (8) for failing to have aquatic invasive species affirmation displayed or available for
2.4 inspection as provided in sections 86B.401 and 97C.301, subdivision 2a, \$25;

2.5 (9) for failing to comply with a decontamination order when a decontamination unit is
2.6 available on site, \$250;

2.7 (10) for failing to complete decontamination of water-related equipment or to remove
2.8 invasive species from water-related equipment by the date specified on a tagging notice and
2.9 order, \$250; and

2.10 (11) for failing to complete the aquatic invasive species offender training course required
2.11 under section 86B.13, \$25.

2.12 (b) A civil citation that is issued to a person who has one or more prior convictions or
2.13 final orders for violations of this chapter is subject to twice the penalty amounts listed in
2.14 paragraph (a).
