Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 290.0132, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.6 to read: 1.7 Subd. 30. Volunteer driver reimbursement. (a) A taxpayer is allowed a subtraction 1.8 equal to the amount of mileage reimbursement paid by a charitable organization to the 1.9 taxpayer for work as a volunteer driver. The subtraction is limited to amounts paid by the 1.10 organization that: 1.11 (1) are in excess of the mileage rate for use of an automobile in rendering gratuitous 1.12 services to a charitable organization; and 1.13 1.14 (2) do not exceed the standard mileage rate. (b) For the purposes of this section: 1.15 (1) "mileage rate" means a per mile rate for computing deductible costs established by 1.16 the secretary of the United States Treasury; and 1.17 (2) "charitable organization" means an organization eligible for a charitable contribution 1.18 under section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code. 1.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for taxable years beginning after December 1.20
