1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 256I.05, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 1s. **Supplementary services rate; Winona County.** Notwithstanding the

1.9 provisions of subdivisions 1a and 1c, beginning July 1, 2020, a county agency shall negotiate

1.10 a supplementary services rate in addition to the monthly room and board rate specified in

1.11 subdivision 1, not to exceed \$750 per month, including any inflationary adjustments

1.12 authorized by law, for a housing support provider located in Winona County that operates:

1.13 (1) a permanent supportive housing facility with 20 one-bedroom apartments for adults

1.14 with long-term homeless and long-term mental health needs; and

1.15 (2) four homes providing part-time supervision and assistance with independent living

1.16 skills for up to ten residents with mental health diagnoses.
