1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 244.44, is amended to read:

1.7244.44 APPLYING EARNED INCENTIVE RELEASE CREDIT.

1.8Earned incentive release credits are included in calculating the term of imprisonment

1.9but are not added to the person's supervised release term, the total length of which remains

1.10unchanged. The maximum amount of earned incentive release credit that can be earned and

1.11subtracted from the term of imprisonment is 17 percent of the total executed sentence.

1.12Earned credit cannot reduce the term of imprisonment to less than one-half of the incarcerated

1.13person's executed sentence. ~~Once earned,~~ Earned incentive release credits are ~~nonrevocable~~

1.14revocable if the person violates rules of the facility where the person is incarcerated or

1.15otherwise commits a criminal act while incarcerated.
