1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.09, subdivision 10, is amended to
1.6	read:
1.7	Subd. 10. Courses according to agreements. An eligible pupil, according to
1.8	subdivision 5, may enroll in a nonsectarian course taught by a secondary teacher or a
1.9	postsecondary faculty member and offered at a secondary school, or another location,
1.10	according to an agreement between a public school board and the governing body of an
1.11	eligible public postsecondary system or an eligible private postsecondary institution, as
1.12	defined in subdivision 3. All provisions of this section shall apply to a pupil, public school
1.13	board, district, and the governing body of a postsecondary institution, except as otherwise
1.14	provided. A course offered under this subdivision must use the same syllabus, final exam,
1.15	and grading scale as the equivalent course offered at the eligible public postsecondary
1.16	system or an eligible private postsecondary institution.
