A bill for an act

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relating to education; requiring a study on concurrent enrollment course.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

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Section 1. CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT STUDY.

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(a) The commissioner of education must prepare and submit to the education policy

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and finance committees of the legislature by February 15, 2016, a written report on

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concurrent enrollment courses under Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.09, subdivision

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10, consistent with this section. The report must include for each concurrent enrollment

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course, at least:

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(1) any differences between a concurrent enrollment course and the sponsoring

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higher education institution's equivalent course in regard to:

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(i) syllabus;

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(ii) final exam; and

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(iii) grading scale;

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(2) the student eligibility requirements;

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(3) the course prerequisites;

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(4) all higher education institutions that have accepted transferring the course for

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college credit;

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(5) all higher education institutions that have denied transferring the course for

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college credit; and

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(6) the frequency at which the course is offered.

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(b) Any costs of preparing this report must be paid for out of the Department of
