1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing a license for the Chaska Athletic Park.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **CHASKA ATHLETIC PARK LIQUOR LICENSE.**

1.5 Notwithstanding any law or ordinance to the contrary, the city of Chaska may issue an
1.6 on-sale intoxicating liquor license for events, other than high school amateur events, occurring
1.7 each year between May 1 and August 30, at Athletic Park located at 725 West 1st Street in
1.8 the city of Chaska. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent
1.9 with this section, apply to the license issued under this section. The city of Chaska is deemed
1.10 the licensee under this section, and the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, sections 340A.603
1.11 and 340A.604, apply to the license as if the establishment were a municipal liquor store.
1.12 The license authorized by this section may be issued for space that is not compact and
1.13 contiguous, provided that all such space is included in the description of the licensed premises
1.14 on the approved license application. The license authorizes sales on all days of the week.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the Chaska City Council
1.16 and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
