Section	on 1. PARAMEDIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.
Sub	division 1. Establishment. The commissioner of the Office of Higher Education
shall es	stablish a program to provide up to 600 scholarships to students entering paramedic
progran	ms by 2025.

2.1	Subd. 3. Administration; award amount. (a) The commissioner must establish an
2.2	application process and other guidelines for implementing the paramedic scholarship
2.3	program. The first set of scholarships must be awarded for the 2023-2024 academic year.
2.4	(b) The amount of a scholarship awarded under this section is \$5,000. The scholarship
2.5	must be paid in a lump sum directly to the institution where the recipient is enrolled.
2.6	Subd. 4. Reporting. By February 1, 2024, and again by February 1, 2025, the
2.7	commissioner must submit a report on the program to the chairs and ranking minority
2.8	members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over higher education finance and
2.9	policy. The report must include the following information and any other information the
2.10	commissioner considers relevant:
2.11	(1) information about all postsecondary programs giving rise to eligibility for a

2.22	(a) \$3,200,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the
2.23	commissioner of the Office of Higher Education for the paramedic scholarship program
2.24	under section 1. Of this amount:
2.25	(1) \$3,000,000 is for awarding 600 student scholarships;
2.26	(2) \$100,000 is for promotion of the program and student recruitment efforts; and
2.27	(3) \$100,000 is for administering the program.
2.28	(b) This is a onetime appropriation. This appropriation is available until expended or
2.29	until June 30, 2025, whichever occurs first.
