BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CORONAVIRUS RELIEF ACCOUNT.

The coronavirus relief account is created in the federal fund in the state treasury. All money received by the state under title V of Public Law 116-136 must be credited to the coronavirus relief account. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 3.3005 and 4.07, subdivision 3, money in the account must not be spent except pursuant to a direct appropriation by law. Money in the account is to pay expenses incurred by the state for the infectious disease known as COVID-19. When all money credited to the account has been spent, the commissioner of management and budget shall close the account.
