1.6	Subd. 1a. Penalty. A person convicted under subdivision 1, clause (2) or (3), is guilty
1.7	of a gross misdemeanor. A person convicted under subdivision 1, clause (1), may be
1.8	sentenced to imprisonment for not more than three 20 years or to a payment of a fine of not
1.9	more than $\frac{5,000}{20,000}$ or both.
1.10	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2024, and applies to crimes
1.11	committed on or after that date.
