The commissioner of the Office of Higher 1.7 Education shall establish a pilot program to provide meal stipends to students enrolled 1.8 1.9 full-time in postsecondary enrollment options (PSEO) courses under Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.09, at two Minnesota postsecondary institutions. 1.10 Subd. 2. Program administration. (a) By September 1, 2024, the commissioner shall 1.11 develop and issue a request for proposals to solicit responses from Minnesota postsecondary 1.12 institutions to participate in the program. By June 1, 2025, the commissioner shall select 1.13 two responding institutions to participate in the program. One selected institution must be 1.14 located in the seven-county metropolitan area, as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 1.15 473.121, subdivision 2, and the other selected institution must be located outside the 1.16 seven-county metropolitan area.
