1.2 1.3	affirming the sovereignty of the people of the State of Minnesota and memorializing Congress to act to nullify laws in violation of that sovereignty.
1.4	WHEREAS, in the American system, sovereignty is defined as final authority, and the
1.5	people, not government, are sovereign; and
1.6	WHEREAS, the people of the State of Minnesota are not united with the people of the other
1.7	49 states that comprise the United States of America on a principle of unlimited submission to
1.8	their federal government; and
1.9	WHEREAS, all power not delegated by the people to government is retained; and
1.10	WHEREAS, the people of the several states comprising the United States of America
1.11	created the federal government to be their agent for certain enumerated purposes only; and
1.12	WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America
1.13	reads as follows: "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor
1.14	prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people"; and
1.15	WHEREAS, powers too numerous to list for the purposes of this resolution have been
1.16	exercised, past and present, by federal administrations, under the leadership of both Democrats
1.17	and Republicans, which infringe on the sovereignty of the people of this state and may further
1.18	violate the Constitution of the United States; and
1.19	WHEREAS, when powers are assumed by the federal government, which have not been
