The commissioner shall adopt rules to set 1.6 standards of assistance and methods of calculating payment to conform with subdivision 1.7 1a. When a recipient is a resident of a licensed residential facility, except shelters for the 1.8 1.9 homeless or shelters under section 611A.31, the recipient is not eligible for a full general assistance standard.
