BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. PUBLIC HEALTH LAB EQUIPMENT UPGRADES; APPROPRIATION.

\$660,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of health to purchase and install equipment for the agency's Public Health Lab that can be used to facilitate remedial investigations and response actions to address discharges of perfluorochemicals by 3M Company and to protect public health and welfare and the environment. The Pollution Control Agency shall reimburse the general fund for this appropriation with proceeds from the 2007 Settlement Agreement and Consent Order entered by and between the MPCA and 3M on May 22, 2007. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until expended.
