Appropriation. \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 17 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of 1.8 Little Fork for predesign, design, site preparation, equipping, and furnishing a campground 1.9 and recreational area. This appropriation includes money for campground improvements, 1.10 including tent and recreational vehicle camping spaces, an ATV wash station and loading 1.11 ramp, and a camp office; recreational improvements, including a fishing dock, a swimming 1.12 beach, and shower and restroom facilities; and road, utility, water and sewer infrastructure, 1.13 and green space improvements throughout the campground and recreational area. This 1.14 appropriation is exempt from the requirements under Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.86, 1.15 subdivision 4. 1.16 1.17 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.18 1.19 the state in an amount up to \$2,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.20 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.22
