1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the erection of a new statue

1.3 in the Statutory Hall in the United States Capitol.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; HUBERT H. HUMPHREY STATUE.

1.6 \$200,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of administration to replace the statue of Henry Mower Rice in the Statutory Hall in the

1.8 United States Capitol with a statue of Hubert H. Humphrey. This appropriation includes

1.9 money for the removal and transportation of the Henry Mower Rice statue to the Minnesota

1.10 State Historical Society, the recasting of the statue of Hubert H. Humphrey that currently

1.11 stands on the mall of the Minnesota State Capitol, and the erection of the new Hubert H.

1.12 Humphrey statue in the Statutory Hall in the United States Capitol. This appropriation is

1.13 onetime and is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota

1.14 Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.15 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
