1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.02, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8Subd. 6. **Manufactured in state.** The commissioner must ensure that all drivers' licenses,

1.9instruction permits, and identification cards are manufactured in Minnesota.

1.10**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2022, and applies to licenses,

1.11permits, and cards printed on or after that date.

1.12Sec. 2. **TRANSITION; APPROPRIATION.**

1.13(a) The commissioner may enter into a contract with a vendor or may purchase equipment

1.14to comply with the requirements of section 1.
