BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. [13.356] PERSONAL CONTACT INFORMATION.

Except where disclosure is specifically authorized by law, and notwithstanding section 13.04, subdivision 2, the personal e-mail address and telephone number of an individual that are collected, maintained, or received by a government entity for notification or informational purposes are private data on individuals, but may be shared with any other government entity for governmental purposes.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and applies to data collected, maintained, or received before, on, or after that date.

Section 1.
