OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the Green Giant Museum
1.3 in Blue Earth; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. CITY OF BLUE EARTH; GREEN GIANT MUSEUM.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$300,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.8 Blue Earth to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip the Green Giant Museum.
1.9 This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and budget
1.10 determines that at least \$150,000 is committed to the project from other sources.

1.11 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$300,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
