OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to local government aid; providing both a onetime and a temporary increase
 1.3 in payment to the city of West St. Paul; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section
 1.4 477A.013, subdivision 13.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 477A.013, subdivision 13, is amended to
 1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 13. **Certified aid adjustments.** (a) A city that received an aid base increase under
 1.9 Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 477A.011, subdivision 36, paragraph (e), shall have its
 1.10 total aid under subdivision 9 increased by an amount equal to \$150,000 for aids payable in
 1.11 2014 through 2018.

1.12 (b) A city that received an aid base increase under Minnesota Statutes 2012, section
 1.13 477A.011, subdivision 36, paragraph (r), shall have its total aid under subdivision 9 increased
 1.14 by an amount equal to \$160,000 for aids payable in 2014 and thereafter.

1.15 (c) ~~A city that received a temporary aid increase under Minnesota Statutes 2012, section~~
 1.16 ~~477A.011, subdivision 36, paragraph (o), shall have its total aid under subdivision 9 increased~~
 1.17 ~~by an amount equal to \$1,000,000 for aids payable in 2014 only~~ For aids payable in 2020
 1.18 through 2034, the city of West St. Paul shall have its total aid under subdivision 9 increased
 1.19 by an amount equal to \$1,840,000.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for aids payable in calendar year 2020
 1.21 and thereafter.

2.1 Sec. 2. **ONETIME GRANT, CITY OF WEST ST. PAUL.**

2.2 \$3,680,000 in fiscal year 2019 only is appropriated from the general fund to the
2.3 commissioner of revenue for a grant to be paid by June 30, 2019, to the city of West St.
2.4 Paul. This is a onetime grant and is not added to the base budget.

2.5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
