- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 65B.28, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 2. **Accident prevention course; rules.** (a) The commissioner of public safety
- 1.8 shall adopt rules establishing and regulating a motor vehicle accident prevention course for
- 1.9 persons 55 years old and older.
- 1.10 (b) The rules must, at a minimum, include provisions:
- 1.11 (1) establishing curriculum requirements; and
- 1.12 ~~(2) establishing the number of hours required for successful completion of the course;~~
- 1.13 ~~and~~
- 1.14 ~~(3)~~ (2) providing for the issuance of a course completion certification and requiring its
- 1.15 submission to an insured as evidence of completion of the course.
- 1.16 (c) The accident prevention course must be a total of four hours.
- 1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2023, and applies to accident
- 1.18 prevention courses held on or after that date.
- 1.19 Sec. 2. REPEALER.
- 1.20 Minnesota Rules, part 7411.7600, subpart 3, is repealed.

7411.7600 REQUIREMENTS FOR APPROVAL AND OPERATION.

Subp. 3. **Course length restrictions.** The course of study may not be less than a total of eight hours, with no more than four hours of instruction required in a 24-hour period.
