[16D.20] FEDERAL OFFSET PROGRAM. 1.6 (a) The commissioner may enter into an agreement with the United States Secretary 1.7 of the Treasury to participate in an offset program authorized under United States Code, 1.8 title 31, section 3716, for the collection of debts owed to state agencies. The agreement 1.9 may provide for the United States to submit debts owed to federal agencies for offset 1.10 against state payments, similar to the procedures for offsetting debts owed to state 1 11 agencies from federal payments. 1.12 (b) The commissioner shall reduce any state payment by the amount of any federal 1.13 debt submitted in accordance with the agreement authorized by this section, and pay such 1 14 amount to the appropriate federal official in accordance with the procedures specified 1.15 in such agreement. 1 16 (c) The commissioner may, by rule, establish a reasonable administrative fee to be 1 17 charged to the debtor for the contingency fee-based procession of state payment offsets for 1.18 the recovery of federal nontax debts or the contingency fee-based processing of federal 1.19 payment offsets for the recovery of state tax and nontax debt. The fee is a separate debt 1.20

and may be withheld from any refund, reimbursement, or other money held for the debtor.
