Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 18B.03, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Administration by commissioner.** The commissioner shall

1.8

administer, implement, and enforce this chapter and the Department of Agriculture is

1.9

the lead state agency for the regulation of pesticides. The commissioner has the sole

1.10

regulatory authority over the terrestrial application of pesticides. A state agency other than

1.11

the Department of Agriculture shall not regulate or require permits for the terrestrial

1.12

application of pesticides.

Subd. 11. **Aquatic application of pesticides.** (a) The agency may issue National

1.16

Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits for pesticide applications to waters of the

United States that are required by federal law or rule. The agency shall not require permits

1.18

for aquatic pesticide applications beyond what is required by federal law or rule.

(b) The agency shall not regulate or require permits for the terrestrial application

of pesticides.
