Section 1. [10A.035] LOBBYING RESTRICTION.

An individual may not act as a lobbyist who attempts to influence legislative or

administrative action for two years after leaving one of the following offices or positions:

(1) member of the legislature;

(2) constitutional officer; or

(3) commissioner, deputy commissioner, assistant commissioner, or head of any

state department or agency.
