1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[61A.032] PRESCRIPTION FOR OPIATE ANTAGONIST.**

1.7 When determining whether to issue, renew, cancel, or modify a life insurance policy,

1.8 an insurer is prohibited from considering whether a person has a prescription for an opiate

1.9 antagonist, as defined in section 604A.04, subdivision 1.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
