1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 13.72, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 20. **Shared mobility program data.** (a) For purposes of this subdivision, a "shared

1.9mobility program" provides transportation services to an individual for compensation using

1.10an Internet-connected application or platform. A shared mobility program includes a

1.11transportation network company as defined in section 65B.472, as well as a person providing

1.12car sharing, bicycle sharing, scooter sharing, peer-to-peer ride sharing, ride hailing, or other

1.13on-demand ride services.

1.14(b) The following data on users of a shared mobility program collected, created, received,

1.15or maintained by a government entity are private data on individuals:

1.16(1) name;

1.17(2) address;

1.18(3) telephone number;

1.19(4) e-mail address;

1.20(5) user name, password, Internet protocol address, and any other similar data related

1.21to the individual's online account or access procedures; and

2.1 (6) bank account number, credit or debit card number, or other financial account
2.2 information.
