1.2 relating to public safety; clarifying the penalties for violations related to Minnesota

1.3 Statutes, chapter 12; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 12.45.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 12.45, is amended to read:

1.6 **12.45 VIOLATIONS, PENALTIES.**

1.7 Unless a different penalty or punishment is specifically prescribed in statute, a person

1.8 who willfully violates a provision of this chapter or a rule or order having the force and

1.9 effect of law issued under authority of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon

1.10 conviction must be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not

1.11 more than 90 days.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
