1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS**

1.6 **ACT.**

1.7 (a) \$315,500,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the trunk highway fund to the

1.8 commissioner of transportation for state road construction to provide for the actual

1.9 construction, reconstruction, and improvement of trunk highways, including design-build

1.10 contracts, internal department costs associated with delivering the construction program,

1.11 consultant usage to support these activities, and the cost of actual payments to landowners

1.12 for lands acquired for highway rights-of-way, payment to lessees, interest subsidies, and

1.13 relocation expenses. The commissioner may use up to 17 percent of the amount for program

1.14 delivery.

1.15 (b) This appropriation is for the purposes of formula and discretionary grant programs

1.16 enacted in the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), Public Law 117-58.

1.17 This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2025.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
