- Subd. 13a. **Instructional materials.** (a) Instructional materials, other than textbooks, that are prescribed for use in conjunction with a course of study in a postsecondary school, college, university, or private career school to students who are regularly enrolled at such institutions are exempt. For purposes of this subdivision, "instructional materials" means materials required to be used directly in the completion of the course of study, including,

- 1.12 (1) interactive CDs, tapes, digital audio works, digital audiovisual works, and computer software.;
- (2) charts and models used in the course of study; and
- 1.15 (3) specialty pens, pencils, inks, paint, paper, and other art supplies for art classes.
- (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (c), if the course of study is necessary to obtaining a

 degree or certification for a trade or career, any equipment, tools, and supplies required

 during the course of study that are generally used directly in the practice of the career or

 trade are also exempt.
