1.5	Section 1. OTTER TAIL COUNTY; PERHAM TO PELICAN RAPIDS REGIONAL
1.6	TRAIL.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,768,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to Otter Tail County to acquire
1.9	right-of-way and to predesign, design, engineer, and construct the Silent Lake and McDonald
1.10	Lake segments of the Perham to Pelican Rapids Regional Trail, which goes from the north
1.11	boundary of Maplewood State Park to the intersection of County State-Aid Highway 34
1.12	and County State-Aid Highway 35. This appropriation is available when the commissioner
1.13	of management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to
1.14	complete the project, as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
