.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 135A.031, subdivision 1, is amended to

.9	Subdivision 1. <b>Determination of appropriation.</b> (a) The appropriations for the
.10	University of Minnesota and the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities are determined
.11	by considering the biennial budget documents submitted under section 135A.034,
.12	performance in advancing the objectives under section 135A.011, available resources
.13	according to the state budget forecast, the relative balance between state support for students
.14	and public postsecondary institutions, and other factors the legislature considers important
.15	in determining the level of state appropriations for public postsecondary education.
