1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. REDUCTION IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR UNFILLED POSITIONS.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Reduction required. The general fund and nongeneral fund appropriations
1.7	to an agency for agency operations for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, are reduced by
1.8	the amount for salary and benefits savings that results from any positions that have not been
1.9	filled within 180 days of the posting of the position. This section applies only to positions
1.10	that are posted in fiscal years 2021, 2022, and 2023. Reductions made under this subdivision
1.11	must be reflected as reductions in agency base budgets for fiscal years 2024 and 2025. This
1.12	section does not apply to:
1.13	(1) any position that requires law enforcement training; or
1.14	(2) any public safety position.
