The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Policy

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to state lands; providing for public sale of certain tax-forfeited land  
1.3 bordering public waters in Cass County.  
1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND BORDERING PUBLIC  
1.6 WATERS; CASS COUNTY.

1.7 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45 and 282.018, subdivision 1,  
1.8 Cass County may sell the tax-forfeited land bordering public waters that is described in  
1.9 paragraph (c).

1.10 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The  
1.11 attorney general may make necessary changes to the legal description to correct errors  
1.12 and ensure accuracy.

1.13 (c) The land to be sold is in Cass County and is described as: Lot 3, Block 1, Jack Pine  
1.14 Shores in Section 28, Township 140 North, Range 31 West (Parcel ID No. 16-470-0130).

1.15 (d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would be  
1.16 best served if the land was returned to private ownership.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
