1.5	Section 1. [60A.0812] PROHIBITED EXCLUSION; CERTAIN PROPERTY
1.6	AND CASUALTY POLICIES.
1.7	An automobile insurance policy, personal excess liability policy, or personal
1.8	umbrella policy must not contain an exclusion of, or limitation on, liability for damages
1.9	for bodily injury solely because the injured person is a resident or member of the insured's
1.10	household, or is related to the insured by blood or marriage.
1.11	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2016, and applies to
1.12	policies issued, renewed, or continued on or after that date.
