1.7	Subdivision 1. Issuance of plates. The commissioner must issue Minnesota 100 Club
1.8	special plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:
1.9	(1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
1.10	truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;
1.11	(2) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
