BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [116.3801] CERTAIN ANTIBACTERIAL PRODUCTS.

1.7

Subdivision 1. **Generally.** No person shall offer for sale in Minnesota any personal

1.8

care products, cosmetics, or cleaning products containing triclosan, triclocarban, or

1.9

similar antibacterial compounds.

1.10

Subd. 2. **Exceptions.** This section does not prohibit the sale of products that are

1.11

used solely in medical facilities.

1.12

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2014.
