1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to energy; requiring public schools to maintain monthly utility consumption

1.3 data; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 123B.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[123B.651] ENERGY USE REDUCTION AND REPORTING FOR PUBLIC**

1.6 **SCHOOLS.**

1.7 Beginning October 1, 2019, each public school or school district reporting on behalf of

1.8 a public school must enter and maintain monthly utility consumption data into the Minnesota

1.9 B3 benchmarking program for all buildings under its custodial control. Reporting by a third

1.10 party, including automatic reporting by an electric or gas utility, may be used to meet this

1.11 requirement. A school or school district must not be penalized for failure to comply with

1.12 this section.
