1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT TRANSFERS AND APPROPRIATIONS;
1.6	SECRETARY OF STATE.
1.7	(a) \$6,595,610 is appropriated in fiscal year 2019 from the HAVA account established
1.8	in Minnesota Statutes, section 5.30, to the secretary of state for the purposes of improving
1.9	the administration and security of elections as authorized by federal law, including but not
1.10	limited to any of the following activities:
1.11	(1) modernizing, securing, and updating the statewide voter registration system and for
1.12	cybersecurity upgrades as authorized by federal law;
1.13	(2) improving accessibility;
1.14	(3) preparing training materials and training local election officials;
1.15	(4) implementing security improvements for election systems; and
1.16	(5) funding other activities to improve the security of elections.
1.17	(b) Any amount earned in interest on the amount appropriated under paragraph (a) is
1.18	appropriated from the HAVA account to the secretary of state for purposes of improving
1.19	the administration and security of elections as authorized by federal law.
1.20	(c) The appropriations under paragraphs (a) and (b) are onetime and available until
1.21	March 23, 2023.
