1.5	Section 1. INCREASE IN MEDICAL ASSISTANCE REIMBURSEMENT RATE
1.6	FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION ADMINISTRATION.
1.7	(a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.76, the medical assistance
1.8	reimbursement rate for administering the COVID-19 vaccination is the Medicare rate for
1.9	health care professionals who administer a COVID-19 vaccine approved by the Food and
1.10	Drug Administration, including through emergency use authorization, to a medical assistance
1.11	enrollee in accordance with the professional's scope of practice.
