1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 174.02, is amended by adding a

1.7	Subd. 2a. Transportation ombudsperson. (a) The commissioner shall appoint a
1.8	person to the position of transportation ombudsperson. The transportation ombudsperson
1.9	reports directly to the commissioner. The ombudsperson must be selected without regard to
1.10	political affiliation and must be qualified to perform the duties specified in this subdivision.
