1.8	Subd. 6e. Revenue allocation among customer classes. Cost of service shall
1.9	be the primary consideration when the commission determines revenue allocation
1.10	among customer classes. Factors other than cost of service may also be considered and
1.11	evaluated by the commission when it determines revenue allocations. Revenue allocation
1.12	among customer classes that deviates from the cost of service must be supported by a
1.13	preponderance of the evidence.
1.14	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> The section is effective the day following final enactment and
1.15	applies to filings for rate changes filed on or after that date.
