1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 357.17, is amended to read:
1.6	357.17 NOTARIES PUBLIC.
1.7	The maximum fees to be charged and collected by a notary public shall be as follows:
1.8	(1) for protest of nonpayment of note or bill of exchange or of nonacceptance of
1.9	such bill; where protest is legally necessary, and copy thereof, <u>\$1_\$5</u> ;
1.10	(2) for every other protest and copy, <u>\$1_\$5;</u>
1.11	(3) for making and serving every notice of nonpayment of note or nonacceptance
1.12	of bill and copy thereof, <u>\$1_\$5;</u>
1.13	(4) for any affidavit or paper for which provision is not made herein, $\frac{1}{5}$ per
1.14	folio, and 20 cents <u>\$1</u> per folio for copies;
1.15	(5) for each oath administered, <u>\$1_\$5;</u>
1.16	(6) for acknowledgments of deeds and for other services authorized by law, the legal
1.17	fees allowed other officers for like services;
1.18	(7) for recording each instrument required by law to be recorded by the notary,
1.19	<u>\$1_\$5</u> per folio.
1.20	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2014, and applies to notary
1.21	services provided on or after that date.
