1.8	with at least one stop-signal arm, prewarning flashing amber signals, and flashing red signals.
1.9	(b) Notwithstanding section 169.80, subdivision 2, a new type A, B, C, or D school bus
1.10	purchased on or after August 1, 2025, must be equipped with a stop-signal arm extension
1.11	that extends a minimum of six feet from the bus.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2025.
