

2.1 (6) one credit of the arts sufficient to satisfy all of the state or local academic standards
2.2 in the arts; and

2.3 (7) a minimum of seven elective credits.

2.4 (b) A school district is encouraged to offer a course for credit in government and
2.5 citizenship to 11th or 12th grade students who begin 9th grade in the 2020-2021 school year
2.6 and later, that satisfies the government and citizenship requirement in paragraph (a), clause
2.7 (5).

2.8 (c) Students beginning 9th grade in the 2021-2022 school year and later must successfully
2.9 complete an online personal finance course for credit during their senior year of high school.
2.10 The course must include but is not limited to the following topics: creating a household
2.11 budget; taking out loans and accruing debt, including how interest works; home mortgages;
2.12 how to file taxes; the impact of student loan debt; and how to read a paycheck and payroll
2.13 deductions.
